Translate all of the following into Korean.

1. A troubling reality is that today's children are less cognitively capable than we were at their age. Since the late 1800s, each generation had typically surpassed the previous one in measured cognitive ability. Although Gen Z has spent more years in school, they are the first not to show this expected increase. Cognitive scientist Horvath attributes the decline to the introduction of screens in classrooms around 2010.
2. When you are doing your best just to hold yourself together and keep going, it can feel isolating, as if no one understands how hard you're trying to keep moving forward without falling apart. No matter how much money or security someone has, they're not immune to this very human experience. That's likely why the Korean phrase 수고했어, pronounced "soo-goh-het-suh," is bringing so many people to tears as they learn about it for the first time.
3. The author was able to generate an entire 50-page children's book in approximately one hour by providing just a few prompts to ChatGPT, underscoring how generative artificial intelligence can dramatically compress the time traditionally required for substantial creative writing. This exercise not only yielded both the narrative content and visual elements such as the cover design entirely through AI, but also serves as a provocative case study for how swiftly machine intelligence can produce what resembles a complete book — a development that is prompting the publishing sector in South Korea to reassess longstanding norms about authorship, quality control, and the economics of literary production in the AI era.

1. Students can face a range of penalties for breaching academic integrity, which is commonly referred to as 'academic misconduct' or 'academic dishonesty'. It is often thought that students rarely get caught. Yet research shows teachers and institutions can detect breaches of academic integrity, and students doing the wrong thing do get caught. And ways of catching cheating are constantly improving. In addition to the risk of academic or criminal penalties, being found to have breached academic integrity can jeopardize students' relationships with other students, professors, and family. Although concerns about the advancement of generative artificial intelligence (AI) technology are becoming increasingly serious, on the other hand, we can also expect positive effects from artificial intelligence. For example, when you dig into the many artificial intelligence benefits and applications, it's clear to see how AI can influence and improve farming around the world. AI programs can, for instance, help farmers make better decisions about how to make the most of their land and resources. They can provide weather forecasts, instructions on when to water crops, suggestions on which pesticides to utilize, and so on. [30점 문항]

3. Benefits of low birth rate could be less of many things we don't like: pollution, climate change, waste, traffic congestion and numerous others. There's even the possibility of some lower prices. For example, one of the reasons costs for shelter have risen so fast is that we have more people competing for good locations to live. Land at preferred locations is fixed in supply. With a slower-growing population, but especially with a population that is declining, price pressures on land and housing would lessen.
