The **Overall Assistance for Startup Immigration System (OASIS)** is a program operated by **Global Start-up Immigration Centers** jointly designated by the **Ministry of Justice** and the **Ministry of SMEs and Startups of the Republic of Korea**, with the aim of promoting domestic startup activities by foreign entrepreneurs with outstanding technological capabilities.

The **Basic Intellectual Property Course (OASIS-1) – 6th Cohort** is jointly organized by the **Global Startup Immigration Center** operated by **Korea Management Association Consultants Inc. (KMAC)** and **Daejeon Support Center for Foreign Residents**.

A. Program Overview

1. Program:

Basic Intellectual Property Course (OASIS-1), 6th Cohort

(This program will be conducted entirely in English.)

2. Objective:

To provide foundational courses required for the acquisition of intellectual property rights (e.g., patents) as well as essential orientation on residency and startup-related requirements in Korea.

3. Eligibility:

Legally residing foreign nationals who intend to establish a technology-based startup in the Republic of Korea.

4. Application Period:

July 27 (Mon), 2026 – August 9 (Sun), 2026, until 24:00 (KST)

5. Application Method:

Submission of required documents, including the application form, sworn statement form and proofs of immigration/residency status, via email.

6. Training Schedule:

August 19 (Wed) – August 20 (Thu), 2026

(Total of 12 hours over two days)

7. Completion Requirements:

Participants who attend at least 80% of the total program will be granted a certificate of completion.

8. Venue:

Daejeon Support Center for Foreign Residents

(2nd Floor, 841 Daejeon-ro, Dong-gu, Daejeon, Republic of Korea)

9. Benefits of Participation:

- Accumulation of OASIS points required for obtaining startup immigration visas (Technology Startup Visa D-8-4 and Startup Preparation Visa D-10-2)
- Eligibility to participate in the next stage of the program (OASIS-2)
- Completion of essential foundational training for technology-based startups in Korea
